

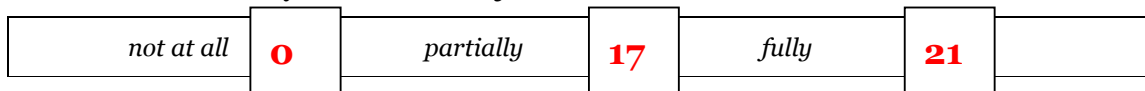


Thank you for attending the seminar at the All Nations Centre Cardiff.
